COLLEGE COUNSELING TIMELINES: PLANNING FOR COLLEGE

ELEVENTH GRADE

- 1. Continue to take **strong**, **college-preparatory courses** and make sure your courses meet the requirements for the kinds of colleges that interest you.
- 2. Make the best grades possible in the most rigorous courses you can handle! Many admissions decisions will be made based on your grades through the junior year.
- 3. Take the **PSAT/NMSQT** in October. This is the year that counts towards their scholarship competition. It's excellent practice for the SAT, too!
- 4. Continue to build a solid personal and extracurricular record through involvement and commitment to your school activities.
- 5. Take the school-day SAT in March. Take additional SAT or ACT tests in April, May, June, or July if you wish.
- 6. Visit colleges. Darlington's winter and spring breaks are excellent times to do this, but you can also take a college leave if needed. The leave form is available in the Student Life Office. Attend college night programs, college fairs, and college-hosted functions in Atlanta.
- Make good use of your summer. Volunteer, get a job, travel, attend a summer program

 anything that interests you! You will find that these experiences may provide material
 for your college application essay(s).

- 9. Be sure to get financial aid information from colleges.
