## COLLEGE COUNSELING TIMELINES: PLANNING FOR COLLEGE

## NINTH GRADE

- 1. Begin mapping out your curriculum plan for all four years in the Upper School. Take English, math, science, history, and world language classes; if appropriate, take **honors and/or Advanced Placement** classes.
- 2. Pursue 2-3 **extracurricular activities** which you enjoy; also pursue those out-of-school activities which are important to you (scouts, volunteer work, community service, dance, piano, etc.)
- 3. Become involved in **leadership roles** in your activities; take advantage of leadership opportunities available to you.
- 4. Begin to familiarize yourself with general college requirements. Check out college websites.
- 5. When possible, talk with college representatives who visit Darlington.
- 6. Work hard in all of your classes! Read more this will improve your standardized test scores!
- 7. Take the **PSAT** in October for experience with standardized testing.
- 8. Make good use of your summer; get a job, go to camp or work as a camp counselor, travel, attend a summer program, etc. You will find that these experiences may provide material for your college application essay(s).
- 9. Make use of family trips to take a first look at colleges.
- 10. Use **Scoir** to explore colleges and search for those that match your interests and abilities.
- 11. **Parents**: begin **financial planning** for college now! Don't wait! Investigate college costs, savings plans, etc., and begin saving now if you haven't already.
