Conference

- post war settlement, terms for defeated nations
- → left bitter legacy
- Georges Clemenceau - France
David Lloyd George - GB
Woodrow Wilson - US } dominated conference
- Central Powers & Soviets not invited

Wilson's
14 pts.

- supposed to be a "just & enduring peace settlement"
- idealistic, favored Allies
- key points (see pg 571)
- defeated powers felt betrayed, had harsh penalties

Peace
Treaties

- series of compromises among victors
- Germany to accept sole resp. for war, & pay for it w/ CP
- Central Powers ↓ military
- Germany & Austria no political union
